



## 2026 Registration Package

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# 1. General Statements

## 1.1 Athlete Eligibility

The boccia competition is open to athletes with a physical impairment that is classifiable under the [Boccia Canada eligibility system](#). Athletes, performance partners, coaches, and officials must be a 2026 member in good standing with OCPSA to participate. Athletes must have competed at 1 Ontario Regional Boccia Series (ORBS) event. Athletes who are 15 and older require classification.

To ensure competition quality, unfilled slots may be offered to athletes of the local club without needing to qualify at ORBS events. This will only be offered if the Technical Delegate and Host decide it is in the best interest of the competition.

## 1.2 Classifications offered

BC1 / BC2 / BC3 / BC4 / BC5 / Senior Impaired / Senior Open / Junior Open

## 1.3 Coach Eligibility

Club Coaches can register to work with athletes affiliated with their own club. Club Coaches will indicate their club during registration. Athletes must have indicated their club during registration. The Call Room will only accept club coaches affiliated with the respective club athletes.

## 1.4 On-court coaches

Coaches and SA must show their accreditation as per rule 7.3. One Coach per side is allowed to enter the Warm Up area, the Call Room and the FOP for each division (ref: 9.2.3) During the End, the Coach must be in the designated area beside the score table in the Coach section. A Coach may be anyone that is registered from the same **CLUB** as the Athlete being accompanied.

All Participants - athletes, performance partners, officials, support & coaches - must register through: <https://ontarioboccia.ca/obc-2026>. The early bird deadline is Friday June 19 at 11:59PM. The regular registration deadline is Friday July 3 at 11:59PM. No additional entries will be accepted after this deadline. Participants can only be registered as one category: athlete, coach, sport assistant, official, or volunteer.

Travel:	Mileage will be reimbursed at \$0.30/km to a maximum of \$300. (Or equivalent if traveling by train or bus)
Accommodation	Athletes residing 45 km's from Quinte Sport & Wellness Centre are eligible to claim \$50 per night (with receipt).
Sport Assistant	BC1 & BC3 players only - up to \$250
